**PHONE** Phone must be capable of calling our 800#. Local calls (and 800# calls) must be free to the guest.

At least one phone in the house should work even if the power goes out.

Grill (prefer charcoal)  
TV (cable or DSS Recommended)

## Furniture

Beds (Queen or King Recommended)  
Living Room Furniture  
Kitchen or Dining table with enough chairs for each person.  
Patio Furniture: table with six chairs

(Spare Bags and Belts)  
Garden hose outside.  
**Spare** Light Bulbs

## Miscellaneous

One complete place setting of dishes and glasses for each person.  
Coffee cups  
Basic cooking utensils  
Pots and pans to cook for a group.  
Bed Linens for every bed (& spare set)  
Bed Spreads, Mattress Pads, and Blankets (1 per bed)  
Towels and wash cloths for each person and a few extra.  
Dish towels 3, and dish cloths 3  
Two hot pads  
Broom and Dust Pan  
Dish Drainer (If no Dish washer)  
Guest Book
